VICTORIA, BC (LEKWUNGEN TERRITORY) – With just two weeks until the 2025 Canadian Little League National Championships at Layritz Little League (July 29–August 7), excitement is building—for fans, families, and travelling teams alike. Here's your ultimate guide to getting here and enjoying the event.

Walk or Bike If You Can!

Layritz Park is located in the heart of Saanich and is easily accessible by foot or bike from many nearby neighbourhoods.

- Bike racks are available in the park, near the playground
- Walking or cycling helps reduce congestion and is a great way to enjoy the summer weather. Let's keep the tournament green and stress-free!

Driving & Parking Options

If you need to drive, we've arranged several parking options nearby. Please respect all posted signage and be mindful of our community partners generously sharing their space. Please only park in designated parking stalls (no parking along the entrance laneway or on the grass).

1. Layritz Park Main Lot - 4328 Layritz Ave.
 - Closest to the field
 - Spaces are limited and will fill quickly
2. Saanich Baptist Church – 4347 Wilkinson Rd.
 - ~12-minute walk to the park
 - No parking on Sundays until 4:00 PM due to services
3. The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints – 701 Mann Ave.
 - ~8-minute walk to the park
 - No parking on Sundays until 4:00 PM due to services
4. PISE (Pacific Institute for Sport Education) – 4371 Interurban Rd.
 - ~8-minute walk to the park
 - Pay parking in effect during the weekdays - free on weekends

Accessibility

There are four accessible parking spots available in the main Layritz lot. Please ensure your permit is clearly displayed. Spectators with accessibility needs can be dropped off/picked up in the roundabout at the main lot.

Public Transit

Several BC Transit routes serve the Layritz Park area, including routes along Wilkinson Rd. and Interurban Rd. Visit bctransit.com/victoria for current schedules and trip planning.

Please Respect Residential Parking Rules

We kindly ask all visitors to observe posted signage and avoid parking in restricted or residential-only areas surrounding Layritz Park.

- Blocking driveways, fire lanes, or ignoring posted “No Parking” signs may result in ticketing or towing.
- Our neighbours have generously supported this event—let’s return that respect with courteous parking choices.

Fan Experience

Three games daily (10:30 AM, 2:00 PM, 5:30 PM) over 10 days—except on semi and final day. See the full schedule [here](#).

- Must-see events: Opening Ceremonies are on Tuesday, July 29 at 4pm. The host team from Layritz will play their first game against Alberta on Wednesday, July 30 at 2pm. The championship game is on Thursday, August 7 at 12pm.
- Daily 50/50 draws - there will be 50/50 tickets sold at each game and the draws will be done each evening around 7pm.
- There will be several porta potties on site as well as plumbed washrooms (limited) at the Prospect Lake Soccer Clubhouse.
- This is a kids little league tournament - please review the [spectator etiquette](#) and safety reminders.

- The Layritz concession will be open at 9:30am everyday offering the ball park meals and snacks you know and love. In addition, [This Week’s Lunch](#) will be offering several healthy prepared meal options including wraps and salads. Credit and debit only.
